Applicant identifies rental unit in the community


Must meet Housing Quality Standards

PHA Determines Rent Portions

- Tenant pays 30% of income toward tenant rent
- PHA pays remaining rent to landlord as the Housing Assistance Payment

PHA Public Housing

Site-based subsidy

PHA owns, manages, and operates units

PHA is the landlord

Rent formula mirrors HCVs



PHA Affordable Housing Developments



- PHAs may have a separate LLC as an affordable housing developer
 - Can apply for Tax Credits (LIHTC)
 - May develop, own, and operate mixed income buildings
 - Braids market rent units with income-based rents
 - No subsidy, just affordable rent based on income limits
 - Can pair a voucher subsidy to rent a unit in the AH development



PHA Special Purpose Vouchers

- Mainstream Housing Choice Vouchers (HCVs)
- Family Unification Program (FUP) HCVs
- Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) Tenant Protection Vouchers (TPVs)
- HUD-VASH (VA Supportive Housing) HCVs



Project-Basing HCVs

- See statutes, regulations, guidance on <u>HUD's Project</u>
 <u>Based Voucher</u> (PBV) landing page
- Generally, PHAs have flexibility to project-base up to 20% of its authorized HCV units.
- This authorization can be increased by 10% up to 30% total for certain types of projects, including those for households exiting homelessness.

VETERAN & CHRONIC HOMELESS PHA PARTNERSHIP

- 120 Vouchers (Miami-Dade)
- CoC layers w/support services for CH referrals (\$200K)
- Revised Orders of Priority:
 - <u>1st Priority</u> Individuals/couples with at least one veteran who has served on active duty, regardless of discharge, experiencing CH and not eligible for VASH
 - 2nd Priority Individuals/couples with at least one member experiencing CH
 - 3rd Priority Individuals/couples with a disability with longest period of continuous or episodic homelessness w/severe service needs

Effective End To Veteran Homelessness



PUBLIC HOUSING REHAB PARTNERSHIP

- 45 Units (Miami-Dade)
 - CoC renovates Public Housing units in need of serious repairs
 - Benefits:
 - CoC provides referrals of homeless households into renovated housing units
 - Public Housing Authority improves its utilization rates
 - CoC agreed to provide PHA \$10K-11,500K per unit (\$250K total)
 - CoC retains referrals rights

FAMILY UNIFICATION PROGRAM (FUP) PARTNERSHIP


- 109 vouchers (81 Hialeah & 28 Homestead)
- Referrals made by Managing Entity for Public Child
 Welfare Agency, but informed by CoC Housing Specialist
- Prioritization for homeless singles, youth, and families
- Trust sits on FUP review team



MOVE-UP PARTNERSHIP

- 54 vouchers 811 Mainstream (44) Miami-Dade
 Section 8 HCV (10) Miami Beach
- Exit Strategy for PSH
- MOU w/PHA
- Assessment Tool Development
- Orders of Priority for Move-Up
 - 1st Priority PSH reallocated or rejected through the HUD NOFA
 - <u>2nd Priority</u>- Formerly homeless households w/minor children
 - <u>3rd Priority</u> Formerly homeless households without children

Know your PHA's

- Use HUD Field Office to make introductions
- Understand portfolios, politics, needs & challenges

Be Proactive: Don't wait for PHA's to call you

- Seek Preferences & Set Asides
- Partner on Solicitations
- Take the lead on shaping MOU's
- Ask to partner on landlord engagement events
- Go back for more

Be Responsive

- Ensure timely referrals
- Reaffirm supports for clients and landlords
- Assist with troubleshooting
